## NCC ENROLMENT NOTICE

### (Army Wing)

First year students both boys and girls, who wish to join NCC are required to report at Play Field near Gym on **10-08-2018 (Friday)** at 10:30 hrs for registration. All interested students should present for scrutinizing by the NCC officials from 21 Pb Bn NCC Kpt unit.

There are only 50 vacancies available. The students have to undergo the physical test for scrutinizing which includes 800m run, Push-ups, 10m Shuttle, Sit-ups and 100m sprint. Students should be in proper uniform and sports shoes for physical test. Those who are suffering from any health issue need not to participate for physical test. Students must be volunteer, physically fit and smart.

The parades will be conducted on preferably during the common slot provided in the time table (Friday 10:30 to 12:30) and if necessary on Saturday or Sunday in the College premises/play fields. The total number of parades during the year will be approximately 50. This includes 15th August, NCC Day, Annual athletic meet and 26<sup>th</sup> January parades. In addition to regular parades cadets also have to attend the annual training camp of 10 days which will be held preferably during vacation.

Apart from the academic requirement of 100 hours in first year of B Tech, Cadets must have minimum 75% of the attendance in subsequent years for appearing to 'B' / 'C' certificate examination. The NCC will be of the total three years duration and the cadets are entitled for 'B' certificate examination only after successful completion of 2<sup>nd</sup> year of NCC and for 'C' certificate examination in the 3<sup>rd</sup> year of NCC along with other stipulated conditions. For cadets it is compulsory to attend the parades without which they will not be allowed to appear in examinations.

Only the selected students after scrutinizing have to fill the enrollment and nomination form available on Institute website along with recent photograph on each form. Further, they have to undergo medical checkup and get the verification of the Doctor on the enrollment form at any urban health center (Govt. Doctor) / any medical practitioner/ Institute Doctor (preferred) at their own.
