OFFICE ORDER

Due to increasing COVID cases in Punjab and especially in Jalandhar and after accessing the current situation of COVID-19 cases at NIT Jalandhar, the following preventive and remedial measures are being adopted taking into consideration the safety and security of the students:-


1. Isolation facility of 20 beds in E-Type quarters for boys and 10 beds at top floor of Mega Girls Hostel for girls has been created under supervision of Dr Manjeet Singh, Warden. The COVID patients shall be provided proper meal as per advice of the Institute Doctors.
2. The students are advised to adhere to the preventive guidelines issued by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and Govt. of India from time to time and advised to contact Institute Dispensary immediately in case they experience any kind of flu-like symptoms and also inform the hostel authority so as to avoid spreading of COVID-19 in the hostels.
3. The students, who are coming back to join the Hostels are required to produce valid negative RT-PCR test report at the time of arrival (done within 72 hours of the arrival in the Institute) as per guidelines issued by the Institute in this regard. In case, the students fails to produce negative (RT-PCR) test as mentioned above, their entry into the Campus will be debarred and their entry will be allowed subject to getting their RT-PCR test done in the nearest reputed Lab that can give report within 24 hours. The facility of institute ambulance will be provided to students for Lab testing, however, they will have to pay for the test at their own. Further, he/she will be isolated in the hostel till the negative RT-PCR report is produced and Rs.1200/- per day shall be charged on account of isolation facilitation charges.
4. The students coming to join the institute with luggage will be properly screened at the Main Gate of the Institute and the Chairman, Campus Safety and Security is required to pass necessary directions to the security staff to remain vigilant across the Institute boundary wall so as to check any sort of trespassing.

All students are advised to adhere to the above guidelines in true spirits so as to avoid spread of COVID and the Chief Warden/concerned Wardens are required to ensure strict compliance of the above instructions.
